BEAUTY SPECIALIST (FIRST YEAR) (CERTIFICATE)

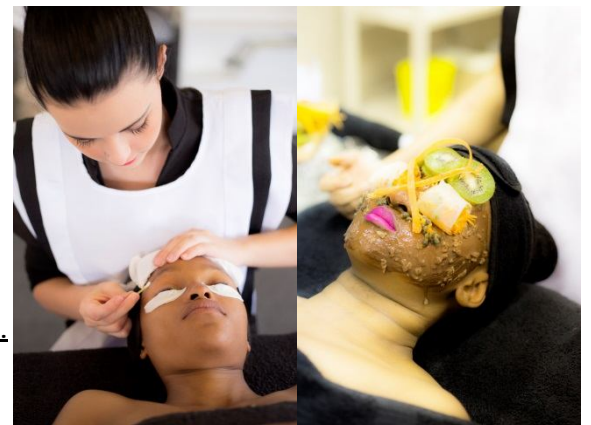

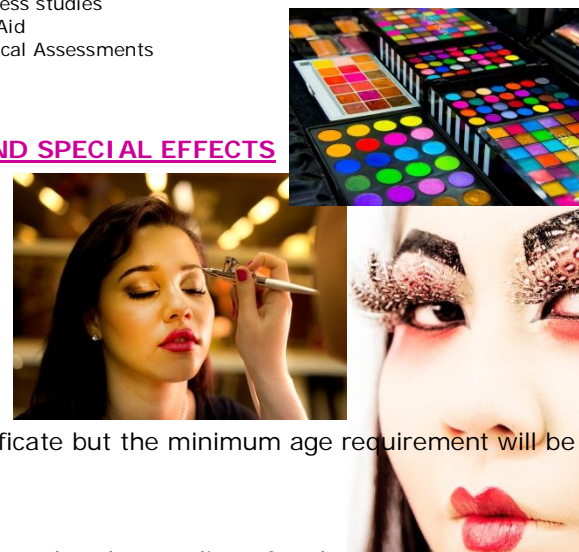
